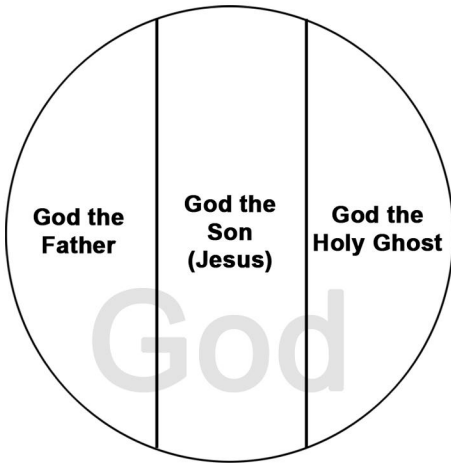
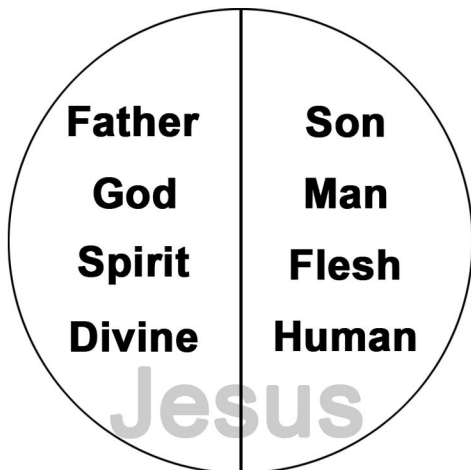


Trinitarian View of God



In this view, God is a unity of three persons. Jesus is just one person in the Godhead, equal to the other persons (Father and Holy Spirit) but distinct from them. In this view Jesus is in the Godhead, but the Godhead is not in Jesus.

Apostolic (Oneness) View of God



In our view, everything about God is contained in Jesus Christ. The fulness of the Godhead dwells in Him (Col. 2:9) and we are truly "complete" in Him (Col. 2:10). There are no other "persons" apart from Jesus. He was both God and man, flesh and Spirit. We are created in the image of God, and share His attributes of flesh and spirit. We are not each three "persons" and neither is He.
